

### THE REAL PRESENCE OF CHRIST



Every time we come to Mass, we will hear **one** of the following Eucharistic Prayers (EP):

**EP I** - Be pleased, O God, we pray, to bless, acknowledge and approve

this offering in every respect; make it spiritual and acceptable so that it may become for us the Body and Blood of your most beloved Son, our Lord Jesus. Take and eat, this is my body. Take and drink, this is my blood.

Later you hear: In humble prayer we ask you, almighty God: command that these gifts be borne to your alter on high in the sight of your divine majesty, so that all of us, who through this participation at the altar receive the most holy Body and Blood of your Son,

**EP II** - Make holy, therefore these gifts, we pray, by sending down your Spirit upon them like the dewfall, so that they may become for us the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Take and eat, this is my body. Take and drink this is my blood.

Later you hear: Humbly we pray that, partaking of the body and blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.

**EP III** - Therefore, O Lord, we humbly implore you: by the same Spirit graciously make holy these gifts we have brought to you for consecration, that they may become the Body and Blood of your Son our Lord Jesus Christ, at whose command we celebrate these mysteries. Take and eat, this is my body. Take and drink this is my blood.

Later you hear: Look we pray, upon the oblation of your Church and recognizing the sacrificial Victim by whose death you willed to reconcile us to yourself, grant that we, who are nourished by the Body and Blood of your Son and filled with his Holy Spirit, may become one body, one spirit in Christ.

**EP IV** - Therefore, O Lord, we pray: may this same Holy Spirit graciously sanctify these offerings, that they may become the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ for the celebration of this great mystery which he himself left us as an eternal covenant. Take and eat, this is my body. Take and drink, this is my blood.


Later you hear: Look, O Lord, upon the Sacrifice which you yourself have provided for your Church, and grant in your loving kindness to all who partake of this one Bread and one Chalice that, gathered into one body by the Holy Spirit, they may truly become a living sacrifice in Christ to the praise of your glory.

We as Catholics, as Orthodox, as Coptic Christians have always believed, (and this was believed by all Christians until approximately the 16th Century [ changed by Protestants]), that when we receive Holy Communion, we are receiving the gift God has given us, Jesus Christ truly present in Communion, which we have given to God as our gift for our salvation. Jesus is present not only in the Word of God, but in the Eucharist we receive. He remains present eternally.

It is not just a remembrance, He is present, now.
